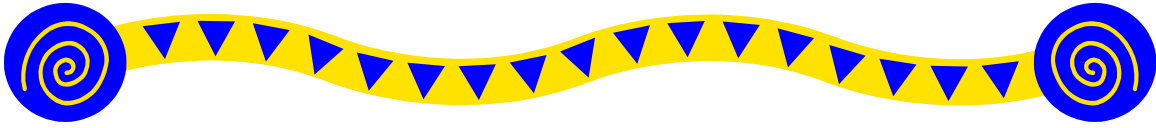


Parents of Children Ages 1st-6th Grade

Dear Sunday School Parents,

Thank you so much for entrusting us with your children in our Sunday School ministry. It is our commitment to you that each week we will seek to guide your children to learn the great love of Jesus Christ as well as leading them to discover the great truths of the Bible.
